1. The Hong Kong Museum of History is exhibiting Heavenly Horse - The Horse in Chinese Art and Culture. Starting with the culture's fascinating development, this exhibition features approximately 60 artefacts from 28 heritage institutes in 14 provinces and autonomous regions. This is the first time that many of the artefacts are displayed in Hong Kong, for example the Qin terracotta saddled horse, the gilt bronze steed and the post station pass from the Yuan dynasty. Delightfully, the Qing dynasty bronze horse head from Yuanmingyuan (the Old Summer Palace in Beijing) is also exhibited.
